A brief summary of greenhouse gas fundamentals will also be included.• Joel Levin from the California Climate Action Registry will summarize the Registry's current activities, the benefits of participation in the Registry and the Registry's responsibilities under AB 32.• Greg Adams, Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts, will speak on the seven-year Water Environment Research Foundation (WERF) project to reduce odors in the wastewater environment and, in particular, from anaerobically digested biosolids. <p>Biosolids Committee</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Diane Gilbert Jones, City of Los Angeles, will speak on biosolids management in Kern County covering litigation, proposed legislation and an update on Measure E.• Layne Baroldi, Orange County Sanitation District, will discuss regulatory trends in Southern California and the future outlook. <p>Collection Systems Committee</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Rebecca Bjork and Manual Romero from the City of Santa Barbara will present the City's recently developed and implemented targeted approach to require property owners to inspect their private sewer laterals in response to SSOs caused by inflow and infiltration. <p>Water Issues Committee</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Larry Chrystal, E.S. Babcock and Sons, Inc., will be discussing laboratory analysis of cyanide samples with CTRs lowered level of 5 µg/l.• Ed Filadelfia, Eastern Municipal Water District, will be speaking on issues regarding compliance with new permit limit requirements for aluminum.• Ashli Cooper Desai, Larry Walker & Associates, will discuss how SSOs can be used to aid in complying with new permit limits.• Julio Lara, Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region, will discuss cyanide issues from the regulators perspective.• These discussions will be followed by an open panel discussion.
