Some of the items on our Home Page:

- The last three SCAP Alerts plus an archive of prior Alerts
- A calendar showing meeting dates, locations, and times (which you may download to your Outlook Calendar)
- A newsletter area that contains our current and archived newsletters, a subscription form, newsletter FAQs, and an Adobe Reader link
- A link to our committee pages where you will find an email link to each of our committee chairs and vice chairs, as well as a listing of our working committee members for each committee
- A link to our Membership Page that contains applications to join SCAP, a listing of our current members, our directors and officers, and our staff
- A link to the Resources page, which includes the public library (there is also a Members Only library in the Members Only section), open job listings and links to sites of interest
- A link to the Members Only section

Members Only Page:

This page has five parts: My Information, References, Featured Agency Profiles, Discussions and Surveys.

- The My Information section provides you with a quick way to change your password and add alerts to your areas of interest that will notify you when a new item is posted to the website
- The Reference section contains Members Only information, organized by committee (we will be adding many new documents and forms available to our members only in the upcoming months)
- The Featured Agency Profile contains an archive of member agency profiles that SCAP has done
- The Discussions area has listings of active discussion forums (at this time, only the Collection Systems Committee has an active forum)
- The Surveys section lists active surveys
